November 20, 2019 – City of Dreams Manila's talented young chefs continue to make their culinary talents shine -- clinching the silver award for the Philippines at the FHC China International Young Chefs Challenge recently held in Shanghai New International Expo Centre.

The culinary team, composed of 25-year-old Michael Monsalve; 24-year-old Rayzel Salvador; 25year-old Jomari Miranda; and led by 23-year-old Rier Franco, is the first ever National Young Chef's team sent by the Philippine Young Chefs Club (PYCC), LTB Chefs Association's youth arm, to represent the country to the global competition, which is known to be judged by esteemed chef-members of WorldChefs or the World Association of Chefs' Societies.

Prior to the international competition, Franco and Miranda also recently bagged gold medals and topped the 2019 Philippine Culinary Cup - Young Chefs Team Challenge.

Under the tutelage of veteran chef and PYCC president Cherrie Uy-Tan, and guidance from City of Dreams Manila's executive chefs Audi Budiman and Markus Tauwald, and executive pastry chef Hoon Sung, the Philippine team competed with 12 other international and regional teams consisting of young chef-delegates from Australia, China, Hong Kong, Malaysia, Penang-Malaysia, Singapore, South Africa, South Korea, Taiwan, Vietnam and the United States.

Tasked to prepare a themed buffet spread for 12 persons, the team's Christmas-themed buffet earned them the silver award, which was judged according to a set of criteria including taste, presentation, professional preparation and mis en place.

FHC China International Young Chefs Challenge, which aims to train young chefs and enrich their competition experience, was held concurrently with the 23rd FHC China, an international food, beverage and hospitality exhibition, and is supported by WorldChefs, known to be a global authority on food.

Currently, Miranda and Franco are part of City of Dreams Manila's banquet kitchen team for the Grand Ballroom, while Salvador and Monsalve are assigned at Qi Long, the 24-hour, exclusive, member-only dining outlet which features Asian and international cuisine and DreamPlay's Chez Gingy, respectively.

The luxury resort's 1,081.20 sq. m. Grand Ballroom can accommodate 600 guests with a round table set-up, and for smaller functions, the ballroom can be divided into three banquet rooms fitting 150 to 200 persons each. The banquet menu is developed, curated and prepared by the chefs from the establishment's award-winning and signature restaurants Crystal Dragon, Nobu Manila and Red Ginger.
