The singer, songwriter, record producer and TV and radio personality is behind the phenomenal rendition of hit song “Love Moves in Mysterious Ways” and other chart-topping singles “Someday”, “Jealous”, “Foolish Heart”, and “Make You Mine”.

Nina made her recording debut in 2002 and having an entertainment career that spans more than two decades earned her recognitions including Favorite New Artist Award on both Awit Awards and MTV Pilipinas Music Awards.
